Johann Louw was born in Belville, Cape Town, in 1965 and graduated with a Masters in Fine Art from Stellenbosch University in 1992. In 2007, the Sanlam Art Collection presented a mid-career retrospective which toured the country in 2008 and 2009, and was accompanied by a publication. Group exhibitions include: Linguaggi del Mondo: Languages of the Worldduring the 53rd Venice Biennale in 2009; Environmental Concern and Human Existence at the 4th Beijing International Art Biennale, China in 2010; Paralleli: Sabbionetta Biennale for Contemporary Art in Italy; and Home Truths, at the Iziko South African National Gallery, Cape Town, South Africa, in 2016. In 2014, Louw was awarded the Ampersand Fellowship.

Johann Louw has presented five solo exhibitions with SMAC Gallery - his most recent, titled 'Der Abschied', was exhibited at SMAC Johannesburg in 2017.
